Summary

- Perform 3rd party application installs
- Create scripts, applets and web tools to assist with monitoring, response, and availability recovery efforts
- Be available on-call to respond to issues affecting availability and performance of the production commercial applications

- Familiarity with business document standards, XML (required), and EDI (desired)
