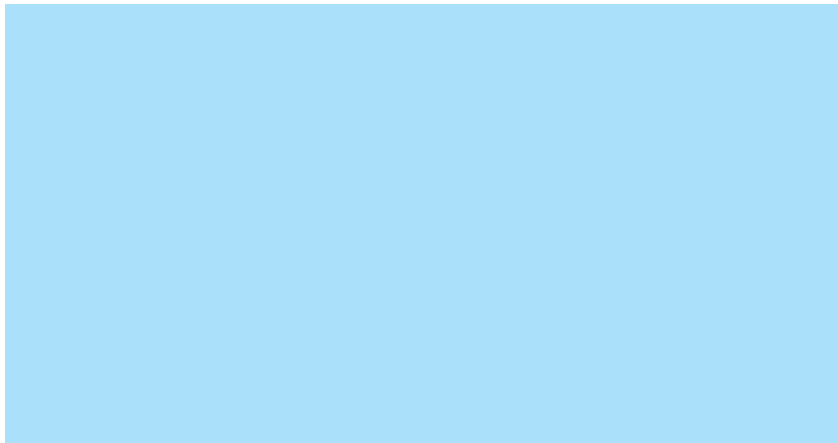

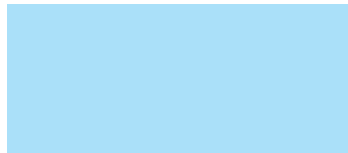

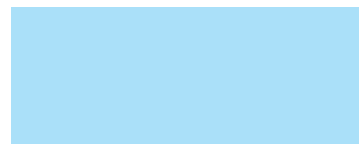

1. As a member of the Company you are entitled to appoint a proxy to exercise all or any of your rights to attend, speak and vote at a general meeting of the Company. You can only appoint a proxy using the procedures set out in these notes. Submission of a proxy form does not preclude you from attending the meeting and voting in person.
2. You may delete the words "the chairman of the annual general meeting of the Company or" and insert the name of your own choice of proxy, who need not be a member of the Company. You may appoint more than one proxy provided each proxy is appointed to exercise rights attached to different shares. If the proxy is being appointed in relation to less than your full voting entitlement, please enter in the box next to the proxy holder's name the number of shares in relation to which they are authorised to act as your proxy. If left blank, your proxy will be deemed to be authorised in respect of your full voting entitlement (or if this form of proxy has been issued in respect of a designated account for a shareholder, the full voting entitlement for that designated account).
3. You may not appoint more than one proxy to exercise rights attached to any share. To appoint more than one proxy, (an) additional proxy form(s) may be obtained by photocopying this form. In the absence of any instructions on the resolutions referred to above your proxy will vote or abstain as he or she thinks fit. Your proxy will also vote or abstain as he or she thinks fit on any other matter coming before the meeting, including on any resolution to amend a resolution or to adjourn the meeting. Proxies may vote on a show of hands and on a poll.
5. To abstain from voting on a resolution, put an 'X' in the box "Vote Withheld". A "Vote Withheld" is not a vote in law which means that the vote will not be counted in the calculation of votes "for" and "against the resolution.
6. To be valid this proxy form must reach the Company's registrars, Link Asset Services of Proxies Department, The Registry, 34 Beckenham Road, Beckenham, Kent, BR3 4TU by 10.00 a.m. on 27 January 2020.
7. In the case of joint registered holders, any joint holder may sign this proxy form, but the vote of the person whose name appears first in the register of members in respect of the holding or his proxy will be accepted to the exclusion of the votes of other joint holders or their proxies. In the case of a corporation, this form of proxy must be executed under its common seal or signed on its behalf by an attorney or officer of the corporation.
8. If this proxy form is executed under a power of attorney or other authority, the power of attorney and other authority (or a notarially certified copy of it) must be lodged with the Company's registrars with the proxy form.
9. If you submit more than one valid proxy appointment, whichever appointment is the last dated (provided that such date is on or before the date of delivery but otherwise regardless of the actual date of execution or the date of its delivery but subject to it being received by the time referred to in note 6) shall be treated as replacing and revoking the others as regards that share.
10. To submit a proxy electronically using the link www.signalshares.com you will need to log into your Signal Shares account, or register if you have not previously done so. To register you will need your Investor Code which is detailed on this proxy form.
11. CREST members who wish to appoint a proxy or proxies by using the CREST electronic appointment service may do so by using the procedures described in the CREST manual. To be valid, the appropriate CREST message, regardless of whether it constitutes the appointment of a proxy or an amendment to the instructions given to a previously appointed proxy, must be transmitted so as to be received by our agent RA10 by 10.00 a.m. on 27 January 2020.
